## Oracy Skills – Individual Presentation

- Make frequent eye contact with your audience.
- Hold cue cards away from your face.
- Project your voice well so that everyone in the room can hear you.
- Be mindful of pace try not to speak too fast so that your audience has time to absorb what you are saying.
- Ensure that your speech is clear every word has a beginning, a middle and an end.
- Use facial and vocal expression to help communicate the content of your speech.
- Be mindful of posture and stance in your delivery.
- Speech should be clear, articulate and expressive.
- Standard English should be used consistently throughout.
- Delivery should be confident.

## Oracy Skills – Group Discussion

- Ensure that you accept and build on the viewpoints of others.
- Respond to the viewpoints of others in a range of ways eg asking a question, making a statement which challenges that viewpoint, making a comment.
- Be mindful of the tone you use to respond to the viewpoints of others.
- Express your own ideas clearly, articulately and expressively.
- Contribute frequently to discussion to allow thorough exploration of the topic.
- Be mindful of body language and facial expression try to ensure that you appear open to discussion.
- Be mindful of posture, and do not have your hands around your mouth when you speak.
- Use Standard English consistently throughout the discussion.
- Take turns to speak throughout discussion.

## Oracy Skills – Role Play/ Drama Activity

- Adapt delivery to suit the task and to engage the audience.
- Sustain the role that you have been given.
- Be mindful of pace and projection.
- Use body language and facial expression to enhance the content of what you are communicating.
- Ensure that your speech is clear, articulate and expressive.
- Be confident in your delivery.
- Take turns to speak throughout discussion.
